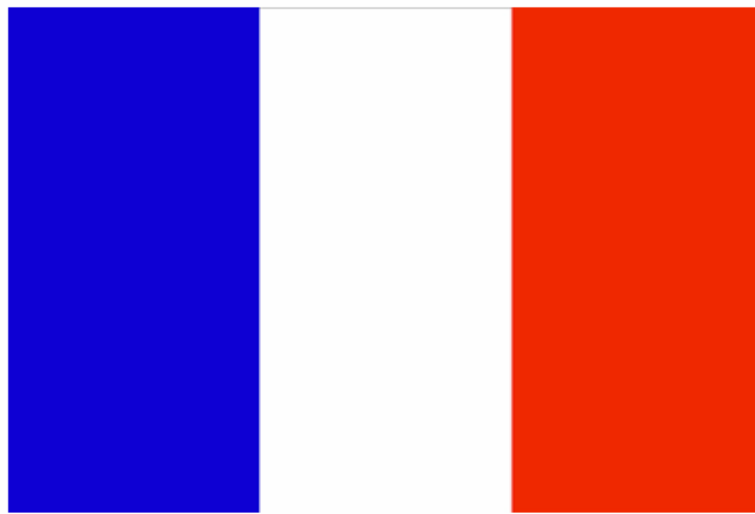

Multicultural night life

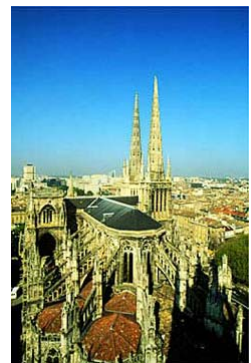
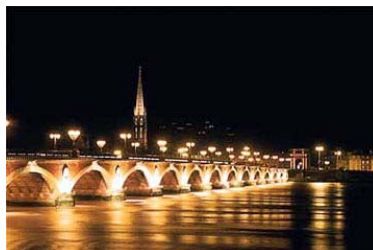
It is not only art, history and culture that encourage the French as well as tourists to visit Bordeaux. It is

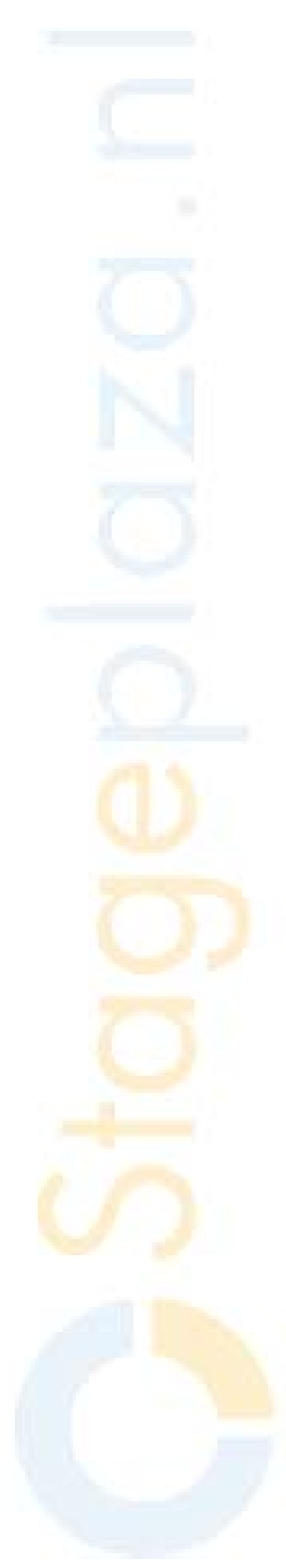


INTERNSHIP PROGRAM IN BORDEAUX

- This is a program with a minimum duration of 2 months, and a maximum of 6 months.
- You are able to carry out an internship in the professional field you choose.
- Internships are located in Bordeaux.
- Before starting the internship, you have the opportunity to attend to an intensive French language course to improve your level of the French language.
- Students with a good level of French do not need to attend to this course.
- You will be assigned a supervisor within the company.
- Your progress will be followed by a qualified consultant of our partners' organization.
- After your internship, you will have a French evaluation, after which, if successful, you will be given a Certification in French language.
- With this program, you will improve your communication and linguistic skills and at the same time you enjoy your multicultural experience abroad!
- You can join our cultural activities around Bordeaux

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- You decided to do your internship through Stageplaza. Great idea!
- First send me an email in which you explain your interest.
- I will contact you and if you decide to do the internship I will send you 3 documents that you have to return to me:
 - **Application Form**
 - **Signed copy of Terms and Conditions**
 - **Copy of your passport.**
- Send alongside these documents your CV (check <http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/>) and your Motivation Letter. A Motivation Letter must contain a description of your level of education and your working experience related to the internship. As well you should motivate your choice for doing this internship.
- At the time you send all these documents, you will need to cover the **Registration Fee**, and this way, everything will be ready to enrol you in the program.

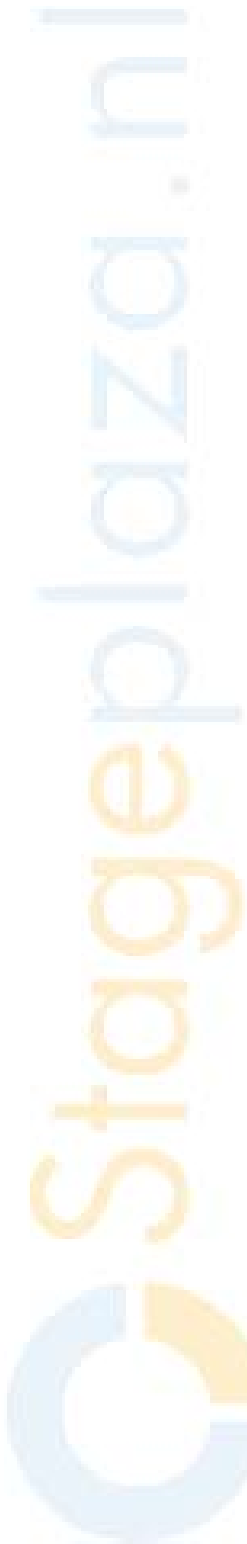
Please note that in the Application Form, you will need to describe what kind of tasks would you like to develop. The more we know, the best we can help you, so the best company we will find. Don't feel afraid of writing a lot, to write too little can cause misunderstandings, and consequently, disappointments (And we don't want a sad face!)

- Your information will be studied by a qualified consultant of Stageplaza and our partner organization, they will accept or decline your booking. (Depending on the possibilities of placing you in a suitable company for your internship, and on your skills and level of the language)
- The total amount of the program must be covered

Please note that in France, the way of arranging internships is quite different when compared to Holland. In France, no employer will accept a trainee without a prior personal interview, to make sure the level of the language and the skills of the participant are as they want them to be. So in France, you first go for an intensive language course. Once your interview has been successful, your adventure is ready to start.

- You have the right to cancel one Work Placement offer, but only for reasonable causes, which will be criticised by a consultant of Stageplaza and our partner organization.
- Once in France, your progress will be followed up and you will always have the help and advise of our partners and Stageplaza.
