In Berlin dense urbanity and a wide variety of recreational offerings can be found side by side.

Also the Berlin's nightlife is very well known! The night starts early and ends late. In all the bars and lounges you start during the happy hours with delicious cocktails and will dance on salsa and tango music. After that you go the coolest clubs on the Savigny Platz in Charlottenburg or the Winterfeldplatz in Schöneberg and you dance till the next morning!



## HAMBURG

Hamburg is the second largest city in Germany and with the Hamburg Harbor, Hamburg is also the second largest port city in Europe. A large part of the port is a fenced-in duty-free area.

But Hamburg is more than just a port. You are also able to find historic blocks of streets with Hanseatic office buildings, warehouses, wattle and daub houses, canals and bridges. This way you can discover Hamburg's romantic historic side!

During the night Hamburg also has a lot to offer. The bars and clubs stay open till 5 a.m. during the week. At the weekend, times are open-ended. Cult shops in the Schanze district, rustic bars in St. Pauli and clubs and discos with DJs from all over the world make sure the Hamburg scene keeps moving and grooving.



## INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

The program can have a duration between 2 and 12 months. You will be able to choose an internship in any professional field. Before the start of your internship you will have the option to follow an intensive language course so that you can optimally prepare your adventure.

Examples of professional fields:

- Graphic & Design
- Electrical Engineering
- Mechanical Engineering
- Civil Engineering
- Architecture
- IT Programming, Database, Network, Webdesign, Serveradministration (therefore we are looking very urgent for an applicant)

The partner also arranges accommodation. Monthly rent can vary from € 300 to €450 per month.

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

- You decided to do your internship through Stageplaza, Great idea!
- Send me your CV (check <http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/>) and a Motivation Letter. A Motivation Letter must contain a description of your level of education and your working experience related to the internship. As well you should motivate your choice for doing this internship.
- With this information I will contact our partner in Germany. They will contact me if there are internships for you.
- I will contact you and if you decide to do the internships I will send you 3 documents that you have to return to me:
  - Application Form
  - Signed copy of Terms and Conditions
  - Copy of your passport.
- At the time you send all these documents, you will need to cover the Registration Fee, and this way, everything will be ready to enrol you in the program.
- Please note that in the Application Form, you will need to describe what kind of tasks would you like to develop. The more we know, the best we can help you, so the best company we will find. Don't feel afraid of writing a lot, to write too little can cause misunderstandings, and consequently, disappointments (And we don't want a sad face!)

- Your information will be studied by a qualified consultant of Globalplacement and our partner organization, they will accept or decline your booking. (Depending on the possibilities of placing you in a suitable company for your internship, and on your skills and level of the language)
- The total amount of the program must be covered

*Please note that in Germany, the way of arranging internships is quite different when compared to Holland. In Germany, no employer will accept a trainee without a prior personal interview, to make sure the level of the language and the skills of the participant are as they want them to be. So in Germany, you first go for an intensive language course.*

- Once your interview has been successful, your adventure is ready to start.
- You have the right to cancel one Work Placement offer, but only for reasonable causes, which will be criticised by a consultant of Globalplacement and our partner organization.
- Once in Germany, your progress will be followed up and you will always have the help and advise of our partners and Globalplacement.

\*Please note that in Germany applicants need to indicate their sex and marital status.
